1. Economic Impact Study

Director laCour provided additional information on the Economic Impact Study proposal including data collection, dates and timing of the when the results would be provided by the NDSU Research team. Director laCour emphasized the importance of this study to supporting the Racing Commission and subsequently the continuation of racing through next legislative session and beyond as state spending is tightened. The Commissioners asked questions and Director laCour answered the questions. Director laCour asked for funding in the amount of \$26,488 from the Promotion Fund to have this study done.
